Journeys

This term the theme of our topic work will be Journeys. Our way into this will be by looking at the Amazon and the journey it takes. We will be thinking about Pilgrimages. After half term, our thinking about journeys will lead to us consider the changes we will be making soon, to secondary school and the journey into adulthood and the changes this will mean for our bodies.

In Art and DT we will be:-

- Evaluate images of water.
- Experiment with water colour painting.
- Collages of water.
- Investigate artists and architects – bridges.
- Create our own bridges from different materials.

In Geography we will be:-

- Naming and locating countries and cities of the United Kingdom, looking at regions and their human and physical characteristics, including how rivers have altered land use.
- Using the points of the compass, including both four and six grid referencing to build their knowledge of the UK and wider world.
- Look at the Amazon River and other rivers.

In History we will be:-

- Looking at a significant turning point in British history.

In ICT we will be:

- Producing a graph in Excel.

In Literacy we will be:

- Sharing the story 'Journey to the River Sea' written by Eva Ibbotson.
- Creating different types of reports.
- Writing in different styles to support our work across the curriculum.
- Exploring different styles of poetry.
- Exploring letter writing.
- Structuring short stories based on an alternative version of Journey to the River Sea.
- Developing our knowledge of spelling, punctuation and grammar.
- Extending our knowledge of authors and types of books.

In Maths we will be:-

- Exploring place value in whole numbers and decimals.
- Multiplying and dividing whole numbers and decimal numbers.
- Multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1,000.
- Investigating angles.
- Transforming shapes – reflecting, rotating, translating.
- Learning about area, perimeter and volume.
- Extending our knowledge of fractions, decimal s and percentages.
- Reading scales and interpreting and creating line graphs.
- Ratio, scale and proportion.
- Measurment – length, weight and capacity.
- Sequences.

In PE we will be:

- Developing our cricketing skills
- Continuing to develop our swimming (Y5)
- Enjoying rounders and athletics.

In PHSE we will be:-

- Learning about taking care of our bodies and thinking about how they change as they get older.
- Continuing to learn about how to be a good friend and resolve issues in relationships

In RE we will be:

- What a pilgrimage is.
- Considering who goes on a pilgrimage.
- Focussing on the religion of Islam and comparing and contrasting it to Christianity

In Science we will be:-

- Investigating how our bodies will change and develop.
