Sports Funding 2018-19

The school funding £17030 at Linby cum Papplewick Primary School has been used to:

- Access the Ashfield District School Sports Network – this provides a rich and varied inter school competitive sports calendar and staff training in the delivery of quality PE and the development of Sports Ambassadors in school (pupils)
- Provide high quality coaching by specialist sport coaches for PE in school (including hockey, basketball, tennis, athletics, cricket, tag rugby, multi-skills, golf, pop lacrosse, dance, gymnastics, table tennis, rounders, swimming)
- Participation in intra & inter-school competitive sports

Impact

Children love sport at our school, participate in lots of extra-curricular sport and standards are very high

- The school was awarded a 'Platinum Medal' accreditation for school sport in 2018-19 academic year following the 'Gold Medals' in 2017-18, 2016-17, 2015-16 & 2014-15 and the 'Silver Medal' in 2013-14
- The school participated in 31 Ashfield District events and was awarded 12 medals (5 Gold, 2 Silver and 5 Bronze) coming 6th out of 36 schools in Ashfield overall.
- Amongst our achievements are retaining the County Football Small School Championship for the fifth year (and competing strongly in the 12 county Midlands finals – reaching the semi-finals), County Hockey runners up boys & girls & being Nottinghamshire Midland Hockey representatives for both boys & girls, fourth in the County Cricket competition & 2nd in the County Quick Sticks Hockey Competiton.
- The school has an extensive range of after school sports clubs (including football, tennis, basketball, table tennis, hockey, dance, cricket, gymnastics) and active links to many local sports clubs

The children's achievements in competitive sport are particularly significant due to the size of our school (117 pupils).
