COVID UPDATE

We are really pleased to share that we have not had any new cases of Covid in school for 9 days. We are also delighted that whilst a good number of our school community have had Covid they have made a good recovery and everyone is safe. In collaboration with Public Health we are pleased we are able to step down the additional enhanced control measures and advise that we are no longer operating in 'Bubbles' in school. As a result you can resume normal pick up and drop off arrangements (there is no need for the One Way system).

We continue to provide good ventilation in the classrooms. To improve ventilation we have windows open (heating is on). Please could you make sure your children have extra layers of clothing to help them to keep warm (vests/school cardigans/school sweatshirts/coats etc.).

CAROL SERVICE

We can confirm the intention is to have a Carol Service at St. Michael's Church on Thursday 16th December from 9.15am – 10.00am. You are invited to come along but would ask that you do a lateral flow test beforehand and also bring a mask. There will be hand gel on entry to the church. We will need volunteers to accompany children to the church and back.

Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Also indicate if you are happy to walk with the children to and from church.

KS1 NATIVITY

Filming the Nativity will mean more people can watch it, it can be watched more than once and the children can watch themselves.
