Pupil Premium Report 2020-21

In the 2020-21 budget we received £14,760 (4 pupils@£1,345, & 4 pupils@£2,345 Pupil Premium Plus). Pupil Premium is spent on additional support in class support, one to one interventions and one to one support with targets, access to targeted maths & literacy programmes, access to computers and software for learning out of school, staff development & training, enhanced transition, curricular enrichment and funding for access to extra-curricular enrichment.

Due to the pandemic Pupil Premium has also been used to support pupils:

- Access 1:1 support remotely
- Access in school learning during lockdown and times of remote learning provision
- Access to catch up support including additional 1:1 in class and out of class support

Current Pupil Premium Spend

In the current budget we received £13,760 (5 pupils@£1,345, & 3@£2,345 Pupil Premium Plus). Pupil Premium is spent on additional support in class support, one to one interventions and one to one support with targets, access to targeted maths & literacy programmes, access to computers and software for learning out of school, staff development & training, enhanced transition curricular enrichment and funding for access to extra-curricular enrichment. Pupil premium funding will also be used towards the school contribution for the National Tutoring Programme and the School Based Catch Up Programme.
