1	<p><b>Can I name three European rivers and locate them?</b></p> <p><b>What are the benefits of rivers been located near to major cities?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I know the names of three European rivers and can locate them on a map/globe.</li> <li>I know how major cities are located close to large rivers and understand that this was due to import and export.</li> <li>I know why rivers are important within communities and why people choose to settle near them (especially, River Trent linked to Nottingham, London on the Thames)</li> </ul>		
2	<p><b>How are rivers formed?</b></p> <p><b>How does the course of a river change over time?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I know how to describe the features of a river in terms of lower course, middle course and upper course.</li> <li>I know how deposition changes the shape of a river.</li> <li>I know what a dam is and can name and locate at least one.</li> </ul>		
3	<p><b>How are four and six-figure grid references used to locate places of interest on a map?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I know how to use four-figure grid references</li> <li>I am starting to understand how to use six-figure grid references.</li> <li>I know how to use six-figure grid references</li> </ul>		
4	<p><b>How have waterways been used historically compared to modern day?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I know how canals/ rivers were used then and now (commercial versus leisure).</li> <li>I know how the geographical features of some UK regions affect usage (e.g. lack of canals in elevated terrain)</li> </ul>		
5	<p><b>What is the impact of human use of natural resources?</b></p> <p><b>How does the work of the Canals and River Trust impact local communities?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I know about the impact of human use of natural resources (water) and debate if this can be sustained.</li> <li>I know about the conservation work of the Canals &amp; River Trust and explain the impact of their work on local communities in terms of leisure, tourism and wellbeing (near the water)</li> </ul>		
6	<p><b>What impact do charities have on providing clean water to different communities worldwide?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I know factors that impact water sanitation and that 1 in 10 people worldwide still have no water at home and how the work of Water for South Sudan has impacted lives in Sudan.</li> <li>I know that not all countries in Africa have poor water sanitation and give reasons for this.</li> </ul>		
7	<p><b>River enquiry - Compare a European river vs River Trent</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I know how a European River compares with the River Trent.</li> <li>I know effective ways to present data from fieldwork and map work to support/challenge a geographical idea.</li> </ul>
