Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the second half of the Summer Term. We hope everyone has had a safe and happy half term break and you have been able to enjoy some of the fabulous weather. Looking ahead, this half term is our busiest so far this year. There are plenty of events and opportunities for both pupils and parents/carers to enjoy before we break up for the summer holidays.

Class Dojo

Class Dojo is a school communication platform that helps teachers encourage children in class that was implemented in the classroom during the Spring Term. Teachers use Class Dojo to give children encouragement (through points that can be earned) for showing specific skills or strengths. Each class has their own points system where they can earn rewards when they reach a certain number of Dojo points.

Class Dojo also has the facility for parents/carers to communicate directly with the class teacher. Previously, if you had wanted to contact your child's class teacher, you might have emailed the class email account e.g. <u>firt@linby.notts.sch.uk</u>. We are now in the process of phasing this system out. Instead, if you need to contact your child's class teacher, we would like you to do this through Class Dojo. Your child will be sent home with a letter which includes a Class Dojo code, that is specific to your child, and instructions on how to join your child's Class Dojo.

If you have any questions on how to access Class Dojo, please speak to your child's class teachers, who are also learning, but will be happy to find out!

Website update

Our school website has continued to be developed over the last two terms. Each class now has a class page where curriculum plans have been added. We endeavour to keep this updated so parents and carers are better informed about what children have been learning in their lessons. Alongside Class Dojo's Class Story, we will be adding photographs that showcase the learning that has taken place both inside and outside of the classroom.

Attendance and holidays

Linby cum Papplewick C of E Primary School has high expectations for every child from the moment they join our school. Children have the right to a high-quality education and we provide this at Linby. High attendance is necessary to ensure that your child benefits fully from the learning opportunities on offer.

At the direction of the government, we are not permitted to authorise holidays in term time. Whilst we understand the pressures on cost of holidays, we are also aware that we have many families that have taken or are about to take holidays in school time. Please consider the impact that this has on both your child's education and the staff that work so hard for your children. There may be lesson objectives that your child misses during their absence that will only be covered again (at a more challenging level) the following school year. The pressure for teachers when they return to help them to catch up is significant and it takes time and resources away from children's education in school.
